LIVING IN COLOR

Did you know that according to shopify.com, "almost half (40%) of U.S. consumers say they've purchased something more expensive than they originally planned because their customer experience was personalized?"

Tattoo and piercing shops are on the cutting edge of personalization when it comes to the services they offer--I mean people are walking through your door to get something done that increases their individuality, right? But what about the jewelry you are offering them? Are you giving them the option to personalize their jewelry choice?

You can if you stock titanium in your case. Titanium, in its raw state is a grey silver color, like steel, but it differs from steel in that it can be anodized to any of the colors in the chart below:



Blue, Bronze, Bluepurple, Dark Blue, Dark Purple, Golden, Light Blue, Pink, Light Purple, Purple, Rosy Gold, Yellow

Anodizing machines use an electric current to manipulate the oxide layer that naturally occurs on the titanium to create color. You will control this natural process by touching a piece of titanium with an electric current dialed to a specific voltage, the titanium reacts and is "coated" with the chosen color. The layer of oxidation varies in thickness based on the requested color--bronze, for example is the thinnest. Since this is a natural process the anodized color does not chip or peel, and the hues that can be created are vibrant and eye-catching. If you're interested in learning more about the anodizing process, Reactive Metals has a great how-to video on their website. It will show you everything from how to set up correctly to how to get perfect hues.



By adding an anodizing machine to your shop, you can give your customers their choice of colors, and also delight them with spectacle of seeing their

chosen piece metamorphose in front of their very eyes (think Mr. Wizard!)--and you can do it without having to stock all the colors of the anodized rainbow. Keeping stock of titanium silhouettes on hand in all your customers' favorite sizes will allow you to custom color any piece a customer wants to change. All you'll need is:

The anodizer with anode and cathode, bowl for electrolyte bath, Phosphate free TSP(electrolyte), nylon mesh basket and a towel to keep your station dry:

The entire set-up, excluding jewelry will cost you \$278.23. If you don't currently carry titanium, you can either purchase pieces a la carte, or contact your Metal Mafia sales rep to put together a starter pack for you. Once you have the above materials, create a dedicated area, about the size of a desk or table, on which to set your anodizing machine, bowls, and other accessories, so you don't have to set up and breakdown continually. If you can do it in a front window where passersby can watch the process, too, you're sure to garner a crowd out front.

Once you've got all the equipment in place and feel ready to start, be sure to market your new service by putting out the word on your social media. You can use color filters on your Instagram, show videos of you anodizing, upload before and after pics of pieces you have anodized, and more. Most importantly, emphasize to your customers that this new addition to your shop is to provide them an even more personalized jewelry experience. Anodizing can usually fetch between \$5-10 per piece, so you'll quickly earn back the expense of the materials.

If you don't have the space or personnel to be able to add anodizing to your shop, you can always allow customers to order custom pieces. Any titanium piece from Metal Mafia can also be anodized by us and shipped ready to sell in the selected color for just \$0.30 extra per piece.

No matter how you look at it, customization is a retail trend that will boost your business and augment your customer engagement and satisfaction. After all, everyone has a favorite color.

QUEEN OF HEARTS... AND PIERCINGS



DIXIE LUGO, QUEEN OF HEARTS, NASHVILLE
ARTICLE AND INTERVIEW BY AMANDA FAGONE

"I grew up in a pack and play in the back room of this tattoo shop," Dixie tells me in a feathery southern accent, "and as I grew, I kind of had it in my back pocket, thinking, 'Well, if I can't figure anything else out, at least I got the apprenticeship done.' However, I ended up falling in love with piercing--as I kept learning the trade, I knew this is where I was supposed to be, this was what I was supposed to be doing. I did go to school to get my associates in pre-law, and though I did love that, it just never truly developed into my passion. I never felt proud of myself doing anything else."

"I really like being able to help educate the community and my clients. I just haven't found joy in anything else the way I do with piercing." I asked if she learned a lot growing up, or if her parents kept her separate from the family business. "My parents definitely instilled at a young age that you have to look out for yourself, you have to be able to provide for yourself, and it's always better to own your own business than work for somebody else, so I was definitely very hands on. I got to learn so much growing up by meeting so many new people, everybody that's ever worked at the studio has touched me in some way, and I've been able to take so much from all of the experiences I had here growing up and through my career."

"It's been amazing learning so many different techniques from so many different piercers, and to see so many people develop here—going from apprenticeships and doing their first procedure to opening their own business-- you make lifelong friends and family in this industry. We're always joking that we spend more time with each other than with our actual families."

Dixie told me that her mother had owned the shop when she was growing up, but not any longer so I asked her how she knew the current owner. She laughed, "Crystal is actually my older sister, and my mom had opened up her first location in Radcliffe, Kentucky, and then she opened up a second Queen of Hearts in Nashville in '93, and I was born in '94. So she had the two locations and my older sister, and then I was born straight into the industry. We've been in the same location since '93."

This is like my second home. When my mom retired, my older sister took over, because I was fresh out of high school and I wasn't ready for the responsibility yet. My sister had been trained from 18 and on to take over the family business – she's made great strides, made some nice changes from the old school look my mom liked to a more modern look. To see how my sister is progressing the legacy is really awesome."

I complimented Crystal on her ability to run the business, and I told Dixie I had always seen her as kind of a bad ass! "You kind of have to be," she laughed, "in this industry. Being a woman... and being a woman in charge, you have to hold your own. My mom raised us to be stubborn little bad asses, so I think she prepared us well for it." I agreed, noting that the industry was dominated for the longest time by men, and also by stereotypes and stigmas. Dixie and I agreed that we liked the way clientele and industry professionals have changed, adding more variety to the types of people that come through their shop and their lives. "It's funny, I work with so many guys, big burly guys with face tattoos- and they're the sweetest guys you've ever met. If anybody was going to try and kick your ass, it would be one of the little girls at the front desk before a tattoo artist!"

"I've been piercing since I was 18, so nine years. I got pregnant during my apprenticeship, learned how to pierce while I was pregnant, and 2 weeks after having my kiddo, I was back in and piercing – and he was in the back with his pack and play, so what happened with me and my sister is what happened with our children. It's cool to see the legacy and teach my kids what my life was like too."

I asked Dixie about her hiatus from the shop, if she had tried to pursue something else, and she shared a vulnerable moment. "It was purely personal, I ended up losing my daughter which took a huge toll on me--and Covid was just shit on top of it, so I let our apprentice take over for a little bit. I took the time I needed and gave the call eventually, and everybody was like 'Well it's about fucking time!'"



"The love, and overwhelming joy, from clients and coworkers missing me, really helped me get over my loss. I was back doing something I loved, and I was cherished by my clients and coworkers, and it gave me meaning. I had a whole different perspective on my career, that it wasn't just a job--it gave me some of my joy back, and it definitely saved me."

I wanted to know what her favorite part of working in the industry was, and it turns out she had something in common with lots of others in the industry, helping her clients get over their insecurities and helping them become exactly who they

wanted to be by putting an earring in their ear, or helping them to love what they see in the mirror. "That's been my absolute biggest reward and a blessing."

"My proudest moments have to be with my son, but I think in being here and being in the industry, and the way I was able to be with my mom, it allows me to respect and honor my mom's memory, and just see all the hard work she put in--finally understanding things about her as a parent that I didn't as a child, as a parent now who is trying to put my footprint on my industry, and say I helped move it forward in some way- and being able to do that with my son, and seeing that he wants to be a tattoo artist and piercer when he gets older. Seeing that it went from my mom, to me, to him, there's three generations that can have an impact on this industry and that's so cool. As a parent you want to give your children the best, but I feel like being in this industry and letting him be around so many different people gives him an open mindset from the start."

"Clients come in with piercing requests, and one of the downsides of the industry is that when people ask for something, they just get turned down with a canned answer like 'We don't do that here' or end up being torn down by others in the industry, or by others who just haven't been educated fully. I think the hardest part is interacting with clients who have been educated poorly or educated wrong, and having a conversation like, 'Look, we're not here to just deny you, but we're here to educate you on why this isn't a good option.' Professional piercers, we bust our asses! We get so much training in OSHA and other aspects so we can make everything safe for us and our clients, and knowing someone can go to

an outlet mall and get the same procedure done that we busted our asses to make sure is healthy and safe for you, and that we're doing the procedure in the best way for the client-when clients still aren't educated in that way, it's frustrating. With technology, you would think education would be more out there, more promoted, but I don't think it's nearly as widespread as many piercers would like it to be. I still witness so many clients who end up with a permanent scar, or injury, because someone took advantage of their vulnerability."



"So many people are on Amazon buying piercing guns now, I cringe every time I see it. They don't even wash their hands before they do an at home piercing... I try to educate people on what they just did and why it's not a good idea. I try to be very open and honest about it, I tell them, 'If you come in with some shit jewelry, I'm gonna talk mad smack to you, okay!' I laugh it off and joke around a lot with my clients, but I make sure to break the tension down so I can get a serious opening and let them know why what they're doing isn't okay. I keep it light so I can keep their attention, and so they know all I want is the best for them. I don't want to take their money and do their piercing, and then have to take it out over a five dollar piece of jewelry."

I thought Dixie looked most up to her mom, who went by Fallen Angel in the tattoo community, and paved the way for them as she had mentioned. To my surprise, she told me that she actually looked up most to her sister, the owner of the shop. "We're eight years apart, so growing up, I got to watch her (Crystal) pierce, and learn to run the shop-she was my role model in life, and ended up being my role model in the industry naturally. I just fell in love with it as I watched her do the procedures in the shop. When I turned 18, I dabbled in tattoo a little bit, but ultimately watching Crystal grow in the industry, helped to foster my love for piercing. We bounce ideas off each other and that tells me that she feels like I'm on her level. I think one of the best moments of my career is when she gave me props. She said that I may have gotten better than her-I do techniques in a different way than she had ever done, it was like, 'Oh shit, I guess I made it now!'"

"I love seeing all the up-and-coming little jewelry companies, but I keep coming back to Metal Mafia because of the variety, reliability, and quality that is consistently offered. It helps me to give my clients something new to look for and I never have to worry that I won't have something fresh for my jewelry case. It allows us as piercers to put quality, fashionable items in clients and bring their ideas to life. My mom was originally the one who chose to work with y'all, and she was very insistent that we had quality jewelry, and I knew she had done research on the companies. I know when I make a jewelry order, I'm going to get my shit! It just makes it easier to do my job."

"I feel like I did fail in my first two years as a piercer. Being raised in the industry and actually doing it and contributing to it are two different things. In the beginning, a lot of people might say that we were handed our careers due to our mom doing it and inheriting the shop-but the other aspect of that is when you're in a family business, you're expected to do the thing and be great at it, and I feel like I did drop the ball really hard at first. It was really overwhelming to step into the industry as a woman, and being only 18, I may not have had some of the correct experience that I needed-I sort of needed to crash and burn and rebuild myself. Trying to get out of just being the daughter of someone so prestigious and growing into my own self required a lot of reading and talking to others in the industry, and time. I had to figure out how do I get respect, how do I make a name for myself? I had to hand out a lot of apologies to colleagues for being a little shit when I was younger. I learned eventually that you do have to take cues from people who have been in the industry for as long as they have."

Dixie spoke with vigor about her ambitions. "Often my sister and I have my mom's career held over our heads-we have had a hard time escaping her shadow. People would tell us 'You'd never be in this industry if it wasn't for your mom, the only reason you own the studio is because your mom started it.' What people don't know is that we spent our entire lives mopping the floors, doing the shit that we've done. If we weren't somewhat good at it, then we wouldn't have lasted as long as we have. A lot of people feel like we ride our mom's legacy, and we do give credit where credit is due, and I don't know if I would be able to go through all the shit my mom and other women at the time had to take from men, photographers, magazines-they were harassed, put down just for being women. The women who came before us have made it tremendously easier, but we still bust our asses to make ourselves known and make our own careers. Half of why I am here is because of her, but the other half is because I busted my ass to be here too. My goal is to be able to look back 10 years from now and say that we helped make the industry the way it is."

Like many others in the industry, it is hard for her to find spare time to do much else. "I don't do too much outside of the industry in my spare time, of course I spend a lot of time looking at other piercers' work and learning more to better myself. I do love fitness and yoga-a lot of people don't realize how flexible I actually am, and that my husband and I lift at the gym! I know this industry takes a toll on the body, I want to be able to still do this when I am in my 50's."

Despite what she's been through the past few years, she still tries to keep a positive attitude with coworkers and clients. "I had a client pass out one day in the front room after a procedure, and I decided to lay down on the floor with her, with her friend, and another client walked in. One of the artists popped out and was like 'Oh yeah, don't worry, we were just playing with a Ouija board!' The client's eyes popped out of her head! Sometimes clients get caught in the middle of our prank wars at the shop."

The last question I asked Dixie was if she had a hidden talent. "Um... I can talk shit really well," she laughed. "I'm pretty good at yoga like I mentioned-I guess my flexibility is my hidden talent!"



Dixie had one last parting note. "For anybody that reads this, that had any type of interaction with my mom - she passed when she had dementia, and she couldn't recognize a lot of people, but one thing my sister and I did towards the end was talk to her about when she started tattooing, and some of her old apprentices, and tattoo artists in the industry. She would always light up and be able to tell us how much they meant to her. She always questioned if she had done enough for the industry, if she had touched enough people, if she had taught enough-I just want some of the guys that are still in Nashville that have made a name for themselves and worked with my mom to know, how much they meant to her. At the end, when she had her viewing, I think the proudest I've ever been of her was the moment when I saw all of these men come back and pay their respects. Seeing all of these amazing artists come back and say 'you helped shape me,' -I feel like it would have been her proudest moment in her career, knowing how many people she touched. All of the artists we've worked with and been able to get to know in our lives, my mom didn't just impact them, they impacted us too. I just want them to know how special and important they are, and they were to her."




